## Midterm I, October 5

Work each problem on a separate sheet of paper. Be sure to put your name, your section number, and your GSI's name on each sheet of paper. Write clearly: explanations (with complete sentences when appropriate) will help us understand what you are doing. Note that there are problems on the back of this sheet, for a total of four problems.

1. Consider the following system of linear equations:

$$\begin{array}{rcl} x_1 - x_2 + x_3 & = & 5 \\ x_3 - 2x_1 + x_4 & = & 2. \end{array}$$

- (a) (5 pts) Write the system in matrix form. (You may either write an augmented matrix or a matrix equation.)
- (b) (5 pts) How many solutions does the system have? Explain your answer. You do not need to find the solutions explicitly.
- 2. Compute the following matrix operations if they are defined. If not, explain why not.

(a) (3 pts) 
$$\begin{pmatrix} 1 & 2 \\ 3 & -2 \end{pmatrix} + 3 \begin{pmatrix} 2 & 1 \\ 4 & 2 \end{pmatrix}$$

(b) (3 pts) 
$$\begin{pmatrix} 2 & 1 \\ 4 & 2 \end{pmatrix}^{-1}$$

(c) 
$$(3 \text{ pts}) (1 \ 2) + {2 \choose 3}$$

(d) (3 pts) (1 2) 
$$\binom{2}{3}$$

(e) 
$$(3 \text{ pts}) \begin{pmatrix} 2 \\ 3 \end{pmatrix} (1 \ 2)$$

3. Let

$$A := \begin{pmatrix} 1 & -1 & 2 & 3 \\ 1 & 0 & 2 & 1 \\ 0 & 1 & 0 & -2 \end{pmatrix}$$

- (a) (5 pts) Find the reduced row echelon form of A.
- (b) (5 pts) What is the rank of A? What is the dimension of the kernel of the linear transformation  $T_A$  corresponding to A? Explain.
- (c) (5 pts) Find a basis of the image of the linear transformation  $T_A$ .
- 4. Let  $P_3$  denote the vector space of polynomials p of degree at most three. You may use the fact that  $\beta := (x^0, x^1, x^2, x^3)$  is a basis of  $P_3$ . Note that  $x^0$  is the constant function whose value is always 1. Let T be the linear transformation from  $P_3$  to  $\mathbf{R}^2$  taking p to  $\binom{p(-1)}{p(1)}$ .
  - (a) (5 pts) What is the dimension of  $P_3$ ? Explain, recalling the definition of dimension.
  - (b) (5 pts) Find a basis for the kernel of T. You do not need to prove that your answer is correct.
  - (c) (5pts) Find the matrix  $[T]^{\beta}_{\gamma}$  for T with respect to the basis  $\beta$  for  $P_3$  and the standard basis  $\gamma := (e_1, e_2)$  for  $\mathbb{R}^2$ .
